


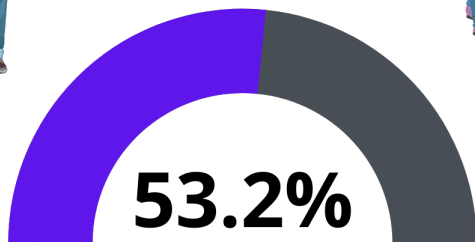
Do Students Think about Making Money along with Studies?

Reporting results about how often students think about making money and what difficulties do they face to earn money.


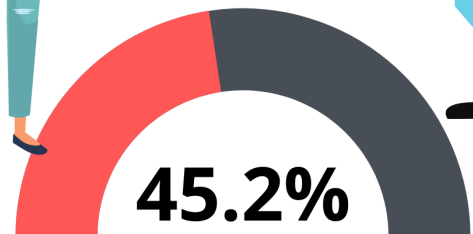

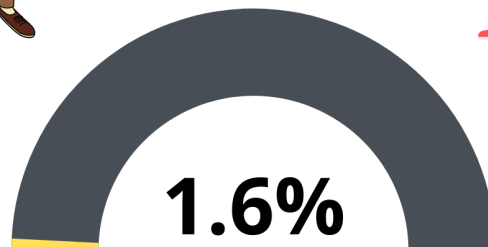
53.2% of students agreed that they **SOMETIMES think of earning money**

Difficulties that Students Face to Make Money along with Studies



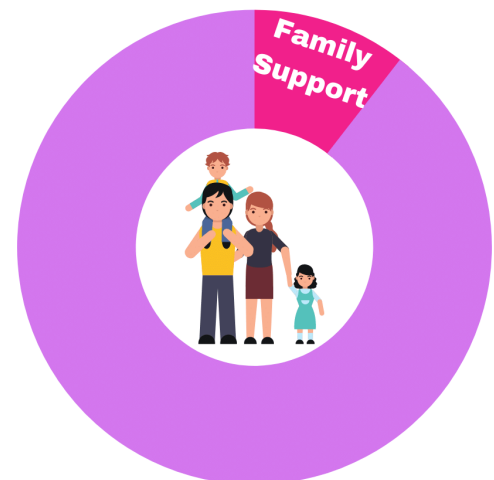
38.6% of students said that they can't manage time. It's difficult to manage time between studies and work.



42.1% of students said that they don't get ideas and don't know how to start.



14% of students said that they have a fear of online scams.



10.5% of students said that they don't get family support to make money as a student.

Abstract-

Objective- To figure out how often students think about making money along with studies and what difficulties so they face.

Methods- This survey was conducted among a group of students between the age 12-22. These students are perusing their academics in different streams.

Results- Among all the students only 1.6% of students said that they don't think of making money. But remaining all the students agreed that they think of earning money along with studies. Also, students said that they face a lot of difficulties to make money along with studies.

Conclusion-

Almost all the students think of making money but time management and lack of awareness about opportunities are the main problems that students are facing.
